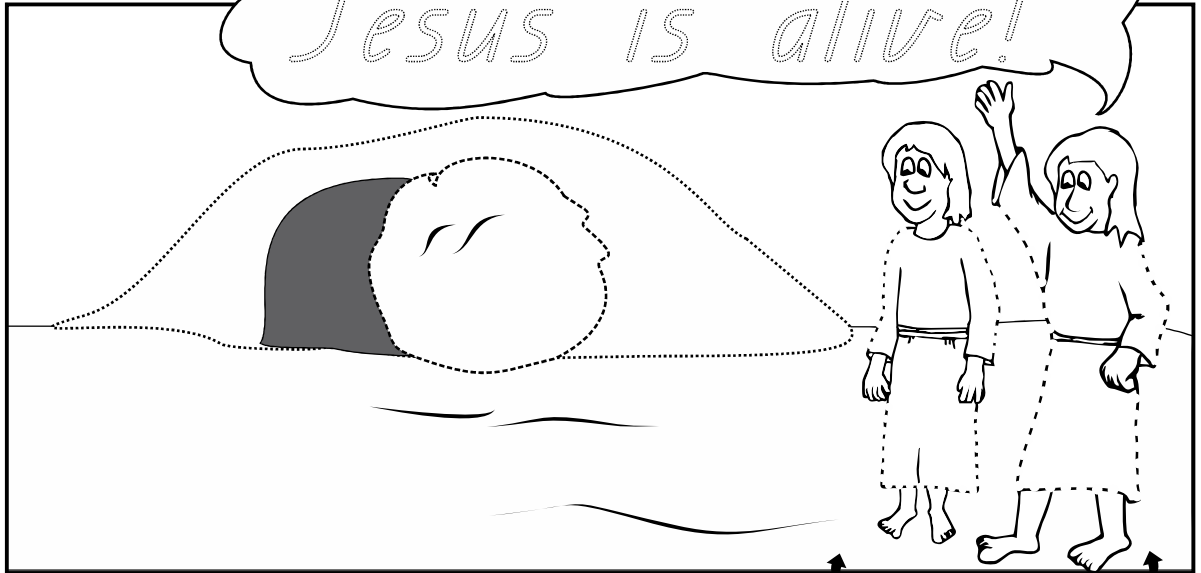

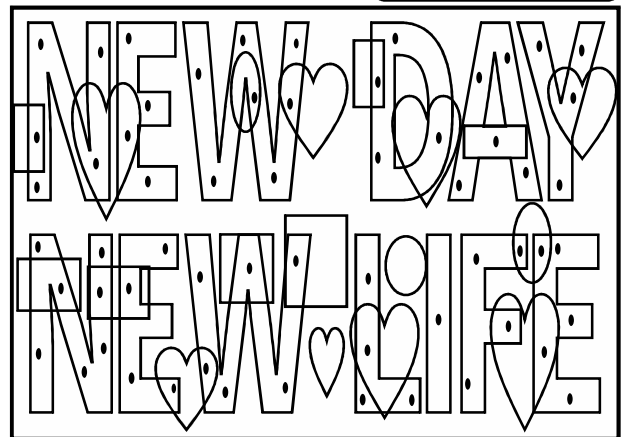

Finish drawing then colour the picture of the early morning when Jesus rose from the dead. Try to show the angels 'gleaming like lightning'.

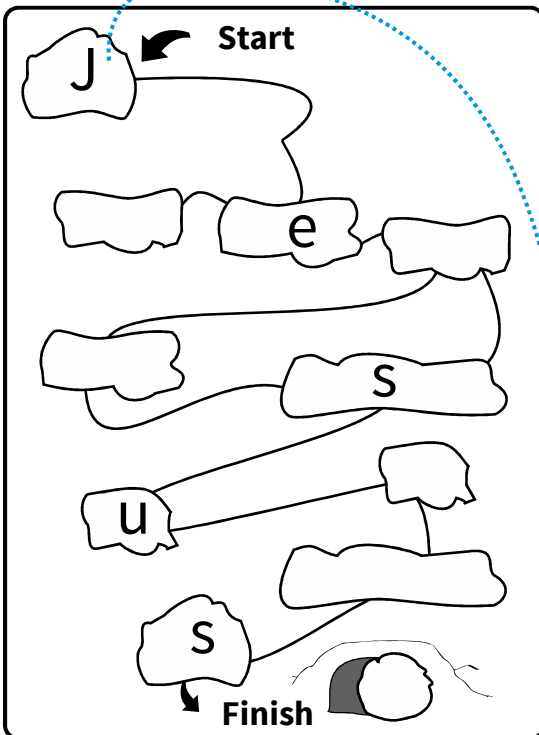
Spot 10 differences between the two angels.

Follow the stones that lead to the empty tomb. Start at 'J' and follow the lines through the maze. Write the letters on the lines in the box below. Have someone read the message to you.

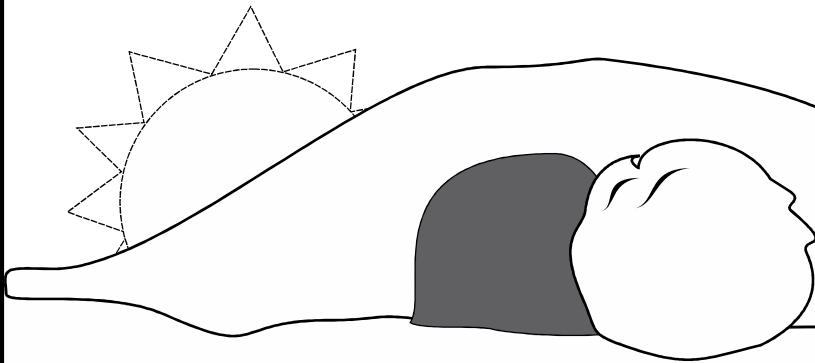

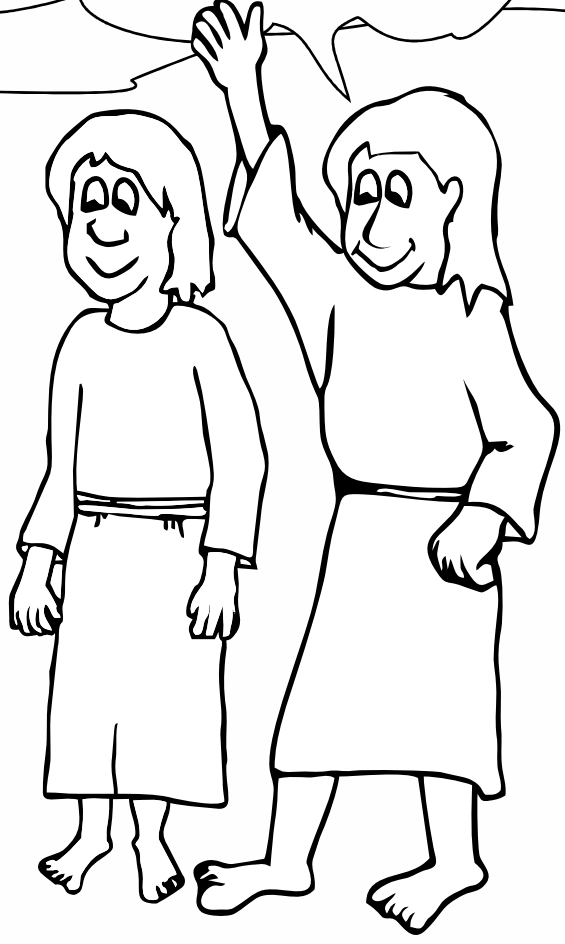
