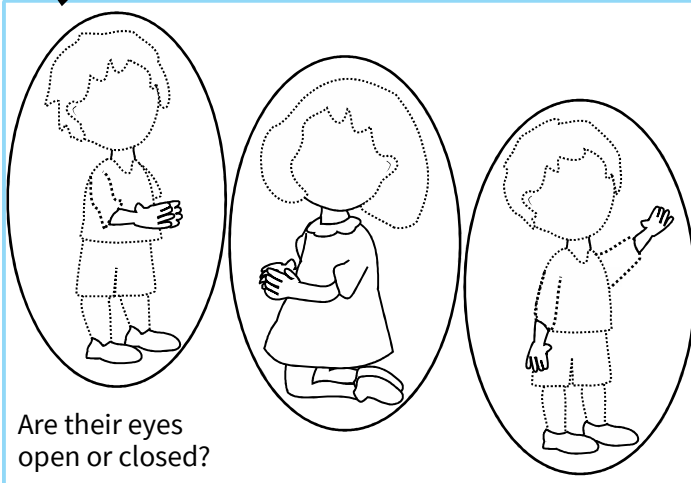

QUESTIONS

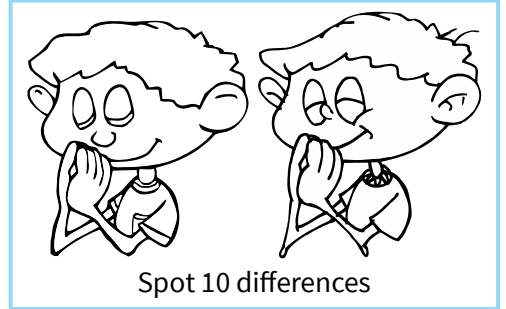
1. What does this psalm teach us about what God is like?

Think: Where could each person be?



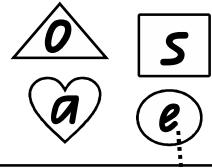
Are their eyes open or closed?

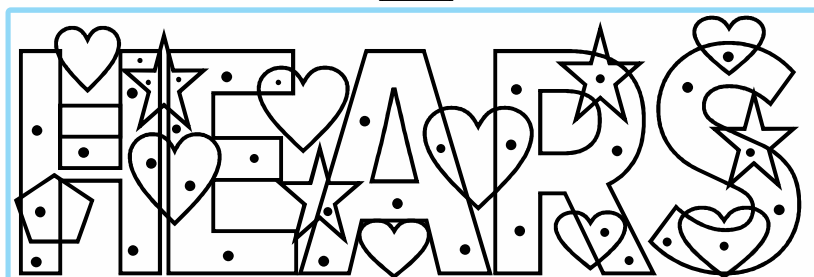
