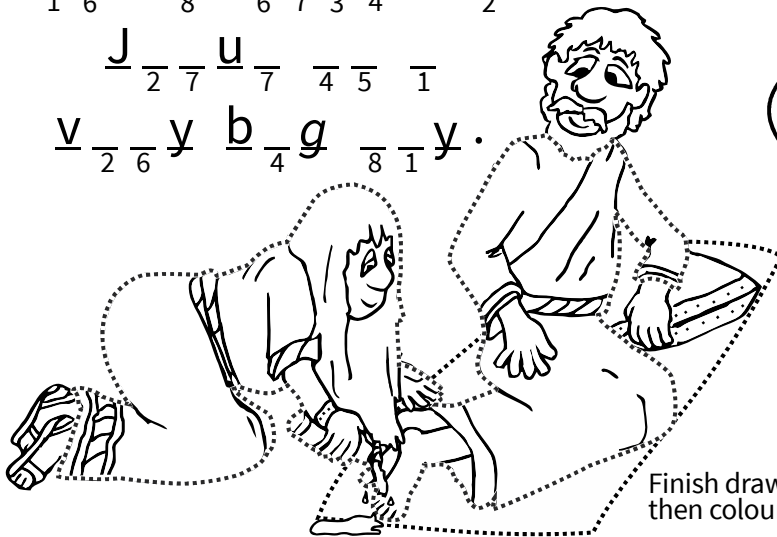

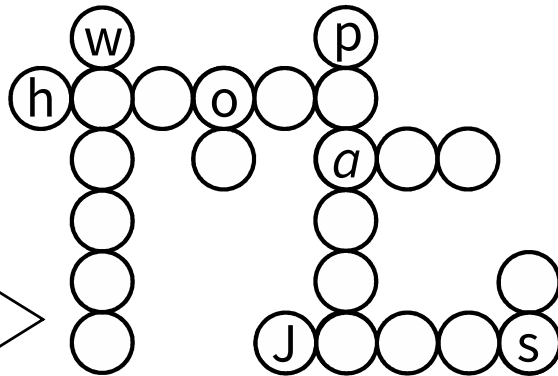
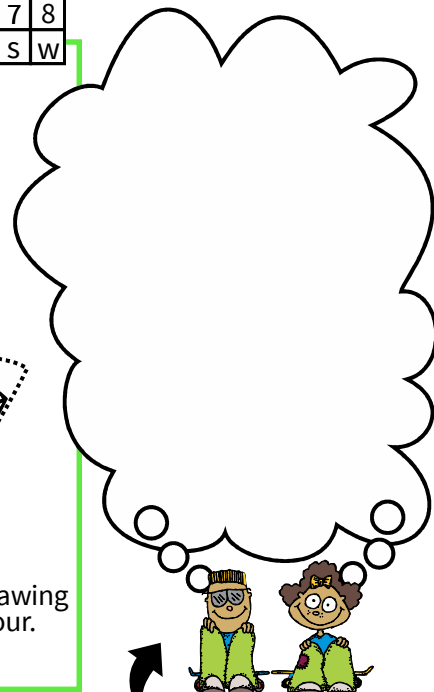
What did Mary do that was so extravagant (BIG)? Tell a friend.
