Some have even taken some tentative steps already on campus or committed to make changes next year in light of it." - after running a Global Missions night for a local AFES group.

A request - "I wanted to reach out to you for a bit of help for a mission series I'm working on.... I was wondering if you have any resources that might be helpful to get students thinking about cross-cultural ministry and what it looks like?" - from a Ministry Apprentice with AFES.

A Vision: 'Eyes and hearts on the global mission of Jesus. Hands and feet in the local mission on campus'. - A local AFES staff worker points students to their Vision every time they meet. And its leading to conversations. Praise God.

IN OTHER NEWS: Many of you will remember my friend Susan from Donggang, Taiwan. Recently she became a grandmother twice over (her son's 'wife'/girlfriend, and her daughter both had kids at the same time). Susan is a Believer, though not yet baptised. Her daughter and daughter's 'husband'/ boyfriend are not Christians. Previously Susan's daughter had a couple of miscarriages. So they see the baby as a blessing from God. Susan asked if my co-workers could baptise the baby even though neither parents are Believers. Please pray - that the whole family might come to faith in the Lord Jesus and want to get baptised together as convicted Believers.
