Q. When does it begin?

An unexpected opportunity to share at the Presbyterian Yr 10-12 Leadership camp - Launch. ‘Is missions just to poor places?’ ‘Is it safe?’ ‘How do I become a missionary?’ Their love for Jesus began in their families and churches - I’m just building on what you and your churches have been doing. Keep your eye on the Global Commission Jesus gave us - Right now - 1) Pray for your church missionary. Find out who your church missionary is, sign up for their prayer letters, and pray for the once a week.
